BACKGROUND

Glasgow has a population of over 600,000 and the City Council serves the metropolitan area of West/Central Scotland with a population of nearly 2.5 million people. The city provides over 350,000 jobs in over 12,000 companies.

CASE STUDY

THE REQUIREMENT

Security and time management were major concerns for the Culture and Leisure Services Division of Glasgow City Council. They needed an access control system with a full ID personnel log to safeguard their buildings and employees.

THE SOLUTION

A STANLEY Astrow time management system was installed to manage flexi-time for the Council's staff and this system was designed to interface directly with the access control system. This cuts down on system administration, enables managers to instantly see who is in the building at any time, and where and when each individual's last point of contact was within the building.

The Astrow system was linked in to the Fire Alarm system so that 'muster lists' could be quickly produced in the event of a fire, with all access doors released to allow a quick and easy evacuation.

In addition, all alarms on the fire and access system are reported to the relevant security staff using STANLEY Aquarius Pagers.
